

What are the charges for emergency medical transport?

- ★ \$1500 for Basic Life Support (BLS) Transport
- ★ \$2200 for Advanced Life Support, Level 1 transport. (Serious medical problems or traumatic injury)
- ★ \$ 3000 for Advanced Life Support, Level 2 transport. (Cardiac Arrest)
- ★ Additional: \$35 per mile from alarm address to hospital.



All EMS charges/rates are set by the Town of Brookhaven following Federal & State Guidelines.

We would like to thank you for your understanding while we always have the community's best interest and safety as a top priority.

Members of Medford Volunteer Ambulance respond to over 3,000 alarms per year. With the steady influx of calls for 911, this process will assist us to work to help offset the tax burden on the Medford residents regarding the expense to operate EMS for the community.

District residents that don't have health insurance or insurance rejects the claim, they can request a hardship waiver form by calling the billing service at (914) 366-4004. The ambulance company may waive the transport charge for financial hardship based on guidelines approved by Medford Volunteer Ambulance Executive Board.

Medford Vol. Ambulance contracts a 3rd party billing company to handle EMS transport billing, coding, and processing. Additionally all patients receive a statement from the billing company that request for additional health insurance information.

Medford Volunteer Ambulance has the option to **waive co-payments and deductibles for district residents.** For those that are uninsured, we have a compassionate billing policy.
